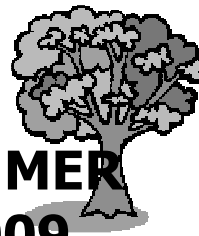

Pinner Free Church CENTENARY 1909/10 - 2009/10



The foundation stones of the church building
were laid on 12th October 1909 and the
building opened on 21st April 1910.

We will be celebrating the Centenary of the

Community in Pinner for 50 years before the
church was built. So it is really 150 years of a
